

Rudolf Steiner Sports Coordinator

To help foster and develop physical activity and wellbeing of all students throughout the school

The Sports Coordinator will

- Organise and provide opportunities for students in the school to partake in various types of physical activities

Sports Management

- Manage and develop the development of sports in the Lower and Upper School.(Primary &secondary)
- Collate the physical interests of school students and meet those needs as adequately as possible.
- Work in collaboration with College Principal Group, the Lower (Primary) School and Upper (high) school teachers, the PE teacher and community to manage and develop physical activity in the school.

Wednesday US sports organisation

- Organise weekly Wednesday sport for students in Classes 8 -10 (yrs 9 – 11)
- Create and enter teams in the Canterbury competitions and organise non-competitive sports both outside and inside the school (e.g. surfing, rock climbing, dance)
- Source and organise qualified coaches/helpers that can help in the running of Wednesday sports and/or provide expertise in areas that could further enhance students experience. (there are a number of coaches already within the school community)
- Organise and manage the timetabling, supervision and running of the weekly sports.
- Facilitate opportunities for student to participate in physical activity outside the school in clubs and organisation

Friday LS sport organisation

- Help lower school teachers to organise teams
- Organise and manage the timetabling and supervision of teams in the Canterbury primary schools competition
- Provide opportunities for coaches or interested helpers to gain or upgrade coaching qualifications

Lower school sporting events

- Facilitate the organisation of the schools Annual Swimming, Cross Country, and Sports (Athletics) day
- Organise the Zone Cross Country event
- Organise students for interschool Zone school sports and Canterbury and National level sports for the Lower and Upper School

Physical activity in the playground (additional if time permits)

- Develop physical activity in the playground
- Organise physical spaces so that students can participate in physical activity and ensure that sufficient equipment is available for physical activity at playtimes and lunch times

The employee will work as an independent coordinator with support and assistance from the PE teacher and previous sports coordinator.

The employee will be responsible to the Principal, College Principal Group and Board of Trustees
